Dear Sir/Madam,

The Telangana Rifle Association, for the second time in the country has decided to hold **2nd Telangana Super Big Bore Open Competition-2026 on 20th August and 21st August, 2026** at Octopus Commando Training Center, Tattikhana, Ibrahimpatnam, Ranga Reddy District, Hyderabad <https://maps.app.goo.gl/QsrZ55brZYDyu5hL8> as per the schedule attached herein.

The objective of conducting this event is to provide an opportunity for the rifle enthusiasts across the country to display their heavy rifles especially double barrel rifle, also provide an opportunity to actually fire and use them on specially designed targets.

The event is being conducted in two categories with a view to train and encourage sportsmanship, inculcating safety and weapon handling protocol.

Eligibility:

1. All NRAI Members / All Other State Athletes/ All TRA Members / All Members of TRA Affiliated District Associations and those persons having valid Arms Licenses to possess N.P. Bore Rifle will be permitted to participate. Shooters shall carry their license or authorization letter in original as per Arms Rules 2016.

2. The Organizing Secretary reserves the right to inspect any weapon and may refuse the entry or disqualify any shooter without assigning any reason considering the safety at the shooting range.
3. Participants using their own arms should be in possession of Valid Arms License.
4. Juniors with Valid Arms License may participate in the competition. However, Junior shooters without Arms License may only shoot under the strict supervision of valid Arms License holder/Guardian, under specific Declaration Form as appended herewith. (Annexure-5)
5. All Matches will be conducted as per the Annexure -1
6. All Participants must follow the Safety Rules and Range Rules as per the Annexure – 2
7. Time Table - Annexure 3
8. Application Form – Annexure 4
9. All participants must submit Form of Undertaking as per the Annexure – 5
10. Borrowing Weapon undertaking as per the Annexure-6

Important Note:

1. TRA reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion and organizing committee's decision will be final and binding.
2. TRA has the right to close any match or event in case of unavoidable circumstances or otherwise without assigning any reason.
3. Matches will commence from 8:00 am, shooters are requested to be present at the firing point 20 minutes prior to match time.
4. Changes in matches are not allowed once the entry is submitted.
5. In any event if the number of participants is three, prizes will be awarded to only two shooters. Likewise, in any event if the number of participants is two the prize will be awarded to only one shooter.
6. All participants must be in possession of competitor card.
7. All participants must be in possession of a Government issued original photo ID (Aadhar/Driving License/Passport).
8. Any shooter violating the safety rules will be disqualified.
9. Fee once paid is not transferable or refundable.

Static Target: The competition will be at a distance of 50 meters on **Static targets** comprising of 10 shots, for sighting one card will be provided, total time for sighter will be Five (5) minutes. Total recording will be 10 shots for 15 minutes. Only single shot loading will be permitted and loading in magazine is not allowed. Those competitors using double barrel rifle will be permitted to load one cartridge at a time.

This is a **bench shooting event**; shooters will be provided a table and chair, using of siling will not be permitted. Shooters will be permitted to use elbows as rest on the table, however a sand bag rest will be permitted for Junior Men/Junior Women, all Women categories and those athletes who are above the age of 70 (Seventy) years.

Note: Semi-Automatic and Automatic Weapons are not allowed.

STATIC TARGET EVENTS

CATEGORY: 1 - Match will be of only 4 Shots

Any Centre Fire Rifle above 8mm calibre will be permitted. Double Barrel Rifles (DBBL) with Telescope/Optic Sights or Open Sight and Single Barrel Rifles (SBBL) with Telescope/Optic Sights or Open Sight. (for Telescope/Optic Sights-25M Precession Target will be used. For Open Sight – 25M Duelling Target will be used)

CATEGORY: 2 – Full Course 10 Shots

Any Centre Fire rifle upto 8mm Caliber will be permitted to be used in this category. Double barrel rifles and below will also be permitted. Double Barrel Rifles (DBBL) with Telescope/Optic Sights or Open Sight and Single Barrel Rifles (SBBL) with Telescope/Optic Sights or Open Sight. (for Telescope/Optic Sights-50M Rifle Target will be used. For Open Sight – 25M Precession Target which will be used)

Match No.14 Double Barrel/Single Barrel Telescope/Optic Sight Rifle above 8mm Calibre Women Individual

Match No.15 Double Barrel/Single Barrel Open Sight Rifles above 8mm Calibre Women Individual

CATEGORY: 2 - Full Course – 10 Shots

Match No.16 Double Barrel/Single Barrel Telescope/Optic Sight Rifles upto and less than 8mm Calibre Men Individual

Match No.17 Double Barrel/Single Barrel Open Sight Rifles upto and less than 8mm Calibre Men Individual.

Match No.18 Double Barrel/Single Barrel Telescope/Optic Sight Rifles upto and less than 8mm Calibre Women Individual

Match No.19 Double Barrel/Single Barrel Open Sight Rifles upto and less than 8mm Calibre Women Individual

Classic Weapon Awards

Best Double Barrel Rifle and Single Barrel Rifle display their rifles and best maintained rifles will be selected by a panel consisting of 3 Officials specially appointed for this purpose. All parameters of the Originality of the weapon like stock, blueing, internal barrel condition of the rifle, engraving, working condition of the rifle will be taken into consideration and additional points will be considered for original screws, butt plate/Pad and other finer details.

Best Classic Weapon Awards will be given for the First, Second and Third positions.

Entries will close on 13th August, 2026.

Annexure - 2 SAFETY RULES

Every person using a firearm must strictly and meticulously follow safety rules. Considering that precious lives are at stake, absolute discipline is a must.

Rigid Rules which must be followed:

1. All rifles will be carried on the range in hard/Soft Cases. When out of the case, bolt action rifles will have their bolts open and safety flag inserted in the breech and double rifles will be carried with breech open.
2. Treat a gun with respect at all times - it is not a plaything.

3. Always point a gun down range whether you are shooting, dry firing, or aiming.
4. A gun must always be kept unloaded except when you are actually firing it.
5. Even if someone tells you a gun is unloaded, assume it is loaded, until you check to make sure it is unloaded.
6. No sooner a command for ceasefire is given, immediately unload your Rifle, open the action, and place it on the table. You may touch a firearm only after the command "load."
7. While loading, keep your finger outside the trigger guard. Finger may be placed on the trigger ONLY when you are ready to lift the arm for a shot.
8. Before touching anybody else's weapon, take his permission.
9. Any person pointing a weapon at another person intentionally or unintentionally will be debarred immediately.

You will always be safe with a firearm if you scrupulously follow the above rules.

Safety - Additional Points

a) EYES

With Indian ammunition you often get powder and shreds of lead flying in all directions. These can cause injury to the eyes. It is necessary therefore, to use eye protector.

b) EARS

Rifle shots are extremely loud and dangerous to the ears. Prolonged exposure to Rifle shots will cause progressive deafness. It is necessary therefore, to use ear protectors. These can be earplugs, ear valves, or earmuffs.

c) SYSTEM-LEAD

All bullets are made of lead which is a very SOFT and also a very POISONOUS metal. By merely rubbing a bullet you will get lead on your hands.

d) Always wash your hands after handling ammunition.

Lead is not only toxic but it is accumulative i.e. it accumulates in the system. Therefore, even small doses are highly dangerous over a period of time.

e) SYSTEM - LUBRICATING OILS

In order to protect Rifle against rust it is necessary to oil them after use. Most oils are harmful and not only that, they contain various chemical additives, which are also toxic. It is therefore necessary to wash your hands with soap and water after handling weapons as a matter of precaution. Of course, the oils MUST be kept out of reach of children.

f) Ensure before firing, the barrel is clear from oil and any obstructions.

RANGE RULES

1. Before occupying the Lane, please sign the Lane Register
2. Keep your Competitor Card and Firearms License handy and show to the Range Office on Duty when demanded.

3. Obey all commands of the Range Officer.
4. Unload your firearm during cease-fire, insert safety flag and keep the weapon on the table pointing towards the target.
5. Follow all Safety Rules.
6. Do not disturb the shooter while he is shooting or relaxing as long as he is in the Shooting Bay, even if is your friend.
7. Please observe complete silence while on the Range.
8. Do not enter Shooting Bay unless you are yourself shooting.
9. Do not smoke and consume alcohol inside Shooting Range.
10. Do not use mobile phone on shooting range.

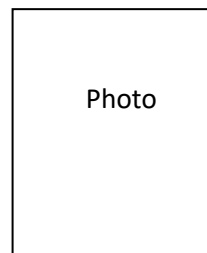
